ENTRY INFORMATION

Entry fees: \$25 per run (including AKC recording/event service fees)

All entry fee checks or money orders (US funds) are to be made payable to CAPER. One check is sufficient for all enclosed entries.

Entries are to be mailed to: BSCA/CAPER. 24902 Apple Rd. Waterford WI 53185.

Entries must be received by 6 pm CDT Wednesday, March 18 after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. No telephone or verbal entries will be accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing (email is acceptable) prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club.

All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are photocopied without the reverse side instructions and agreement included. Checks returned for insufficient fees will have the entry cancelled; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging. Express & certified deliveries must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without receipt signature. Entries received without signature release will be refused.

Entries with email addresses will be acknowledged with an email receipt. Confirmations and judging schedules will be emailed after closing. If you want a hard copy confirmation mailed, please note this on your entry. CAPER is not responsible for non-delivery of emails due to delivery errors or spam blockers, and no further efforts will be made.

Refunds: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date; in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Event Committee; or in the event that extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Event Committee make it impossible to open or complete the trial. Entries for bitches who come into season after the closing date will be refunded less \$5 per entry if written notice is given to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of judging.

Fax/email entries: Entries may be faxed to the Secretary at 206-222-2830, or emailed to secretary@ caper-dogs.com. Both sides of each entry form must be included, completely filled out and signed, or the entry will not be accepted. Payment can be made via PayPal or credit card by going to www.caper-dogs. com/PayPalCCpayment.htm and following the instructions there. Payment must include the \$2 per class additional charge to be valid. Entries are complete when both entry form and payment are received.

Entry errors: Exhibitors are responsible for the correctness of entries. All entries which include an email address will be sent an entry verification email shortly after receipt. All errors will be corrected prior to closing; exhibitor errors discovered after closing cannot be corrected. Overpayments of less than \$5 per dog will not be refunded.

All Container classes, both trials

Trial Information

- There will be TWO scentwork trials held on one day. Entries are limited to 125 runs per judge.
- · Entries are accepted via First Received method, Belgian Sheepdog entries preferred. Hand-delivered entries are not allowed. No envelope can have more than 10 dogs' entries included.
- This trial is open to all dogs 6 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number (for mixed breed dogs), or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.
- · Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, the dog displays no sign of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Deaf and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from an injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance may not participate. No dog shall compete if it is sutured, bandaged, or has any visible wounds.
- · By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely.
- * Entries for bitches who come into season after the closing date will be refunded less \$5 per entry if written notice is given to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the event.
- · CLASSES AND ORDER: All levels (Novice, Advanced, Excellent, Master) of Container and Buried are offered in each trial. Trials will run concurrently for each level in each element - e.g., Novice Container class will run Trial 1, followed immediately by Trial 2. The two elements will be running at the same time. The order of the classes will be determined after closing and will be outlined in the judging schedule. There will be NO moveups in level between the two trials.

Check-in will begin at 8am, briefing at 8:30, and judging at 9am.

- WAIT LIST: 20 runs per trial will be held on a wait list for entry into the trial. Full refunds will be given to withdrawn entries replaced by a waitlisted entry, and all waitlisted entries not accepted into the trial.
- COLLARS, LEASHES & HARNESSES: During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material.

All dogs must be on leash at all times. Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search. An offleash option may be offered at the discretion of the judge, only if the area is completely enclosed.

 POSSESSION OF ODORS AND TRAINING: Chapter 5. Section 26 of the Scent Work Regulations state "No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm-up area."

The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the handler-dog team prior to their run, or for recovery after the run. The warm-up area is not for training or relieving of the dog.

- SPECTATORS: Spectators are encouraged. No food/drink or dogs allowed in the spectator areas.
- SEARCH AREA CONDITIONS: Searches will be indoors on protected carpet or tiled surfaces. Search areas may be of any shape, and of the size specified in the Regulations for each class.
- · STAGING AREA: There will be an area with limited crating, warm-up boxes, waiting area, and secretary's table for check-in and posting of running order and scores

- Travel South on I-26 East and merge onto I-240 West
- Stay in the right lane, marked as an "Exit Only" for Exit 3-B (labeled Westgate and Resort Dr)
- · Merge into the right lane as you pass the Westgate Shopping Center
- Our driveway is IMMEDIATELY ON THE RIGHT as you round the curve

From South (Asheville Regional Airport; Greenville/Spartanburg, SC; Columbia, SC)

- Travel West on I-26; Follow signs for I-240 to Asheville
- Merge into the left lane and take exit 3A onto Patton Ave

Owners and agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs when their run is called. The club, judges, stewards and secretary have no obligation or responsibility to announce for or locate dogs that are not ready to run when required.

Exhibitors should follow their Veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
